Examination Details	Component 1 - A portfolio containing a sustained project. 96 marks. 60% or the final grade.
	Component 2 – A 10 hour practical exam with a preparatory period. 96 marks. 40% of the final grade.
Controlled Assessment	Component 1 is formed of at least one sustained project to demonstrate a variety of skills. This is
	supported by any further work that students would like to include.
Exam Paper Details	Component 2 exam questions for students to choose from are issued at the beginning of January.
	Students are given a preparatory period to research and develop ideas and are given 10 hours of
	supervised time in which to make the textile piece of work that they have designed.
Key Topics	Skills development will be demonstrated using a variety of topics such as 'pattern' and 'identity'. Examples
	of these skills are batik, machine skills, surface decoration, dye, embroidery and constructions techniques.
