Students will be assessed formally on every activity in seven-week blocks. These grades will go through a moderation process in Faculty meetings prior to results being processed.

GCSE PE

- Students will be assessed every lesson with an element of exam questioning. This will be feedback in a variety of ways including verbal, peer or teacher.
- All homework will feedback via teams and Kaboodle and the official OCR website will be used as a source interactive engagement.
- Teacher feedback from work on exam questions, extended writing or practical evidence will be provided by the teacher on a regular basis. This will include a grade and ways to improve mark.
- Practical logs will be assessed every half term to monitor performance for part of the NEA.

V-CERT NCFE Health and Fitness

- The synoptic project will be marked, and feedback given in line with official NCFE guidelines.
- Regular homework will be set for all units through Teams. Feedback will be given either verbally, written or through lessons. Where appropriate homework could include past exam questions, knowledge of relevant content, research, or quizzes.
- For external units, students will be assessed with timely progress tests. This will include a mark and grade relevant to the part of the specification being taught.
- Classwork will be assessed where relevant and feedback provided verbally or written.

A Level

- Students will be assessed every lesson with an element of exam questioning. This will include both standard question papers and extended questions. This will be feedback in a variety of ways including verbal, peer or teacher assessment.
- All feedback in relation to homework will take place via teams and the official OCR website will be used as a source of interactive engagement. This will include regular use of MS forms as a source of low stakes testing giving both teacher and student instant feedback.
- Practical logs will be assessed every half term to monitor performance for part of the NEA.
- Practice EAP's will be carried out when appropriate and feedback given to the student including mark and grade.
- Practical logs will be assessed every half term to monitor performance for part of the NEA.
- Progress tests will be carried out at multi points throughout the year, giving assessment opportunities to generate evidence for inform current learning grades.

BTEC Level 3

- All assignments will be disseminated to students in line with the assessment grid and IV process.
