

DENBIGH SIXTH FORM – UCAS support timeline

Year 12 Mentoring programme, Sept to April, has regular reference to Universities, Careers, Personal statements, Open Days, etc.

May of Year 12 – UCAS website opens for students to start exploring/researching

May of Year 12 – Year 13 entry exams

June of Year 12 – mentoring focuses on Open Days and UCAS Fayre at a local university

June of Year 12 – Work Experience (1 week)

July of Year 12 – Post 18 Options Day – focus on UCAS and Apprenticeships, starting the application process.

Summer holidays Y12-13

Students complete MOOCs, gather skills for personal statements, complete academic reading, gain further work experience, attend Open Days/Summer Schools, etc.

September of Year 13 – Personal statement support in Mentoring.

UCAS opens for submitting applications.

Year 13 Team arrange practice interviews for early applicants, in school.

October 15th of Year 13 – deadline for early applications (Oxford, Cambridge, Medicine, Vets, Dentists) – at 1800hrs.

End of November of Year 13 – school deadline for UCAS submission.

Mid-January of Year 13 – UCAS deadline for equal consideration.

Students can still apply after this but they are not guaranteed an offer or to be considered.

Year 13 Mentoring programme, Feb to May – continued support for UCAS, decision making and student finance.
