

Year 11:	Curriculum Intent: Students will consolidate their understanding of all the GCSE Geography topics. Students will have previously completed all of the content for paper 1 (physical), and all the content for paper 2 (human). Therefore, year 11 will focus on diagnosing any gaps and filling these. The rest of the time is spent developing exam skills and their ability to do well on paper 3 (enquiry and fieldwork skills). Students will develop their understanding through re-examining case studies of real places to allow them to build application skills and provide examples to support their answers.
